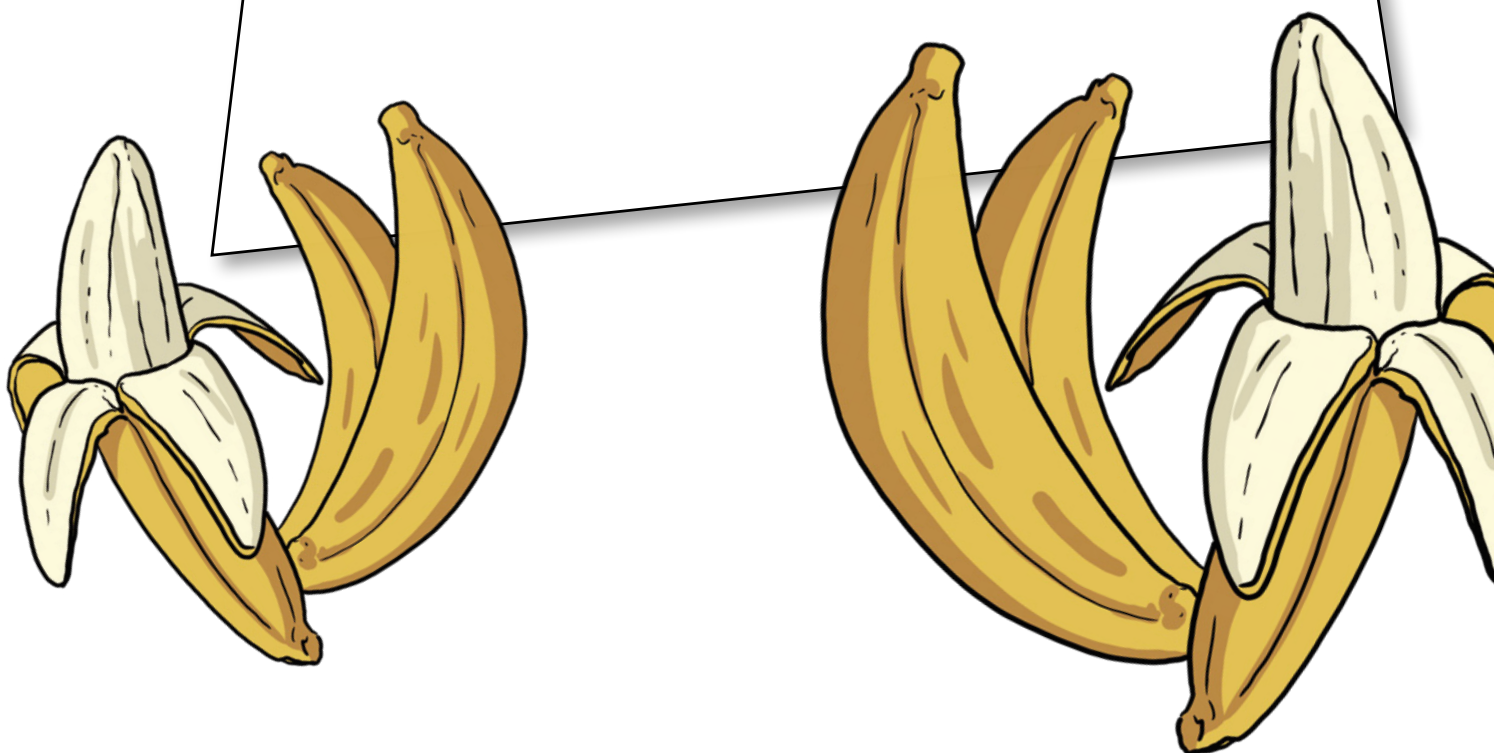

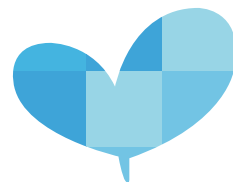

Answers: 10-12, into fructose, 20,000 kilos, three and half to four days, to control the temperature of the bananas.



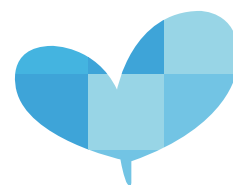

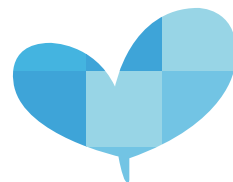

This world map illustrates the history of banana cultivation since 600 BC.

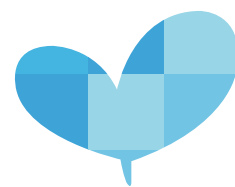
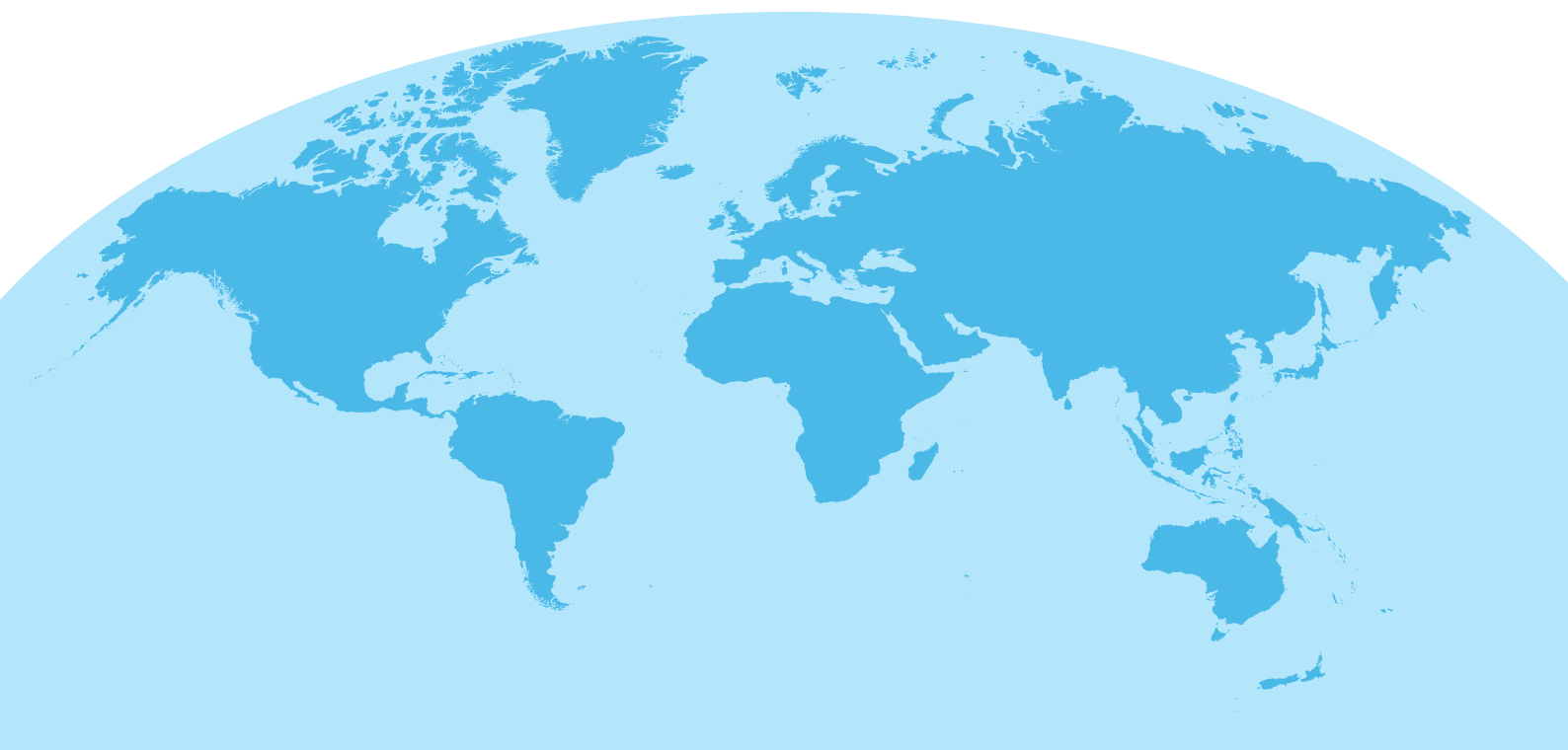
Banana cultivation began in southwestern Asia in 600 BC.

In the 15th century, thanks to the Portuguese, it was brought to the Canary Islands.

Then Spaniards took it first to Santo Domingo, where it then spread to all of America.
