E) Bagging process in the hoppers.

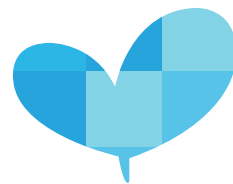
F) Laboratory study to control the quality of the potatoes.

Do you like potatoes? What's your favourite way to eat them? There are countless recipes that use potatoes. Why not create your own recipe book?



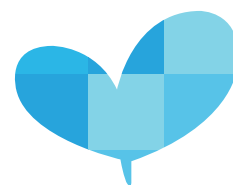
